


Install VirtualBox On MacOS

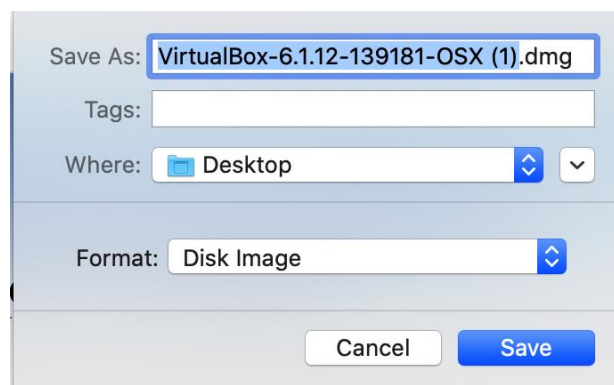

1] Navigate browser to the link above.

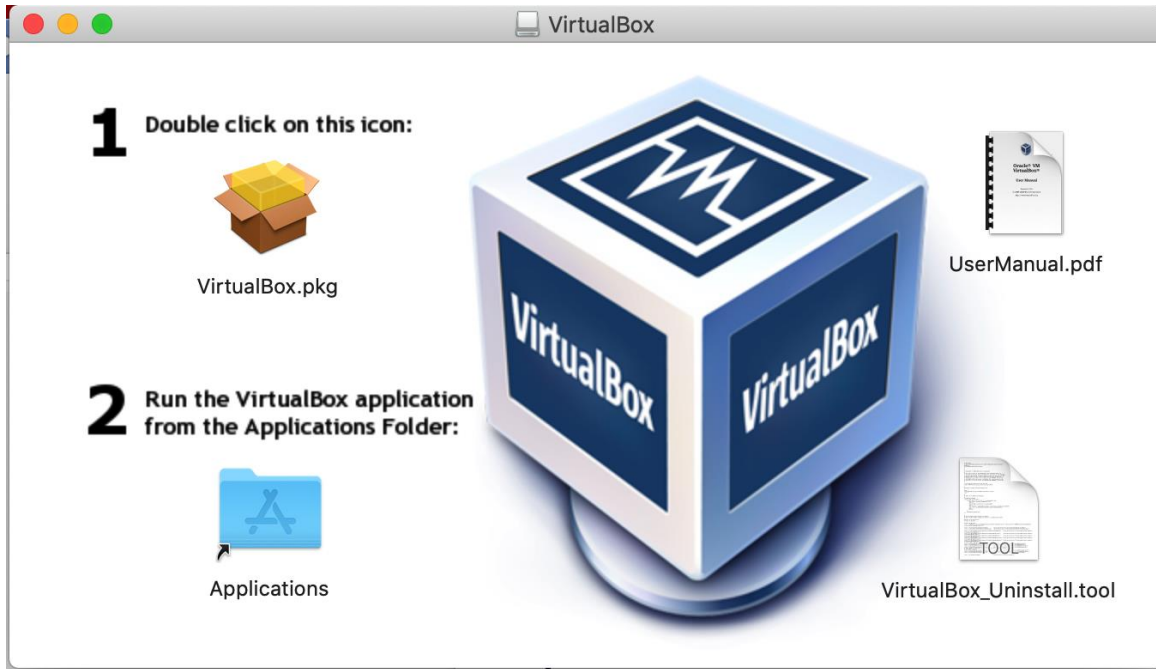
2] Select the OS X download.



3] Download it to your desktop.



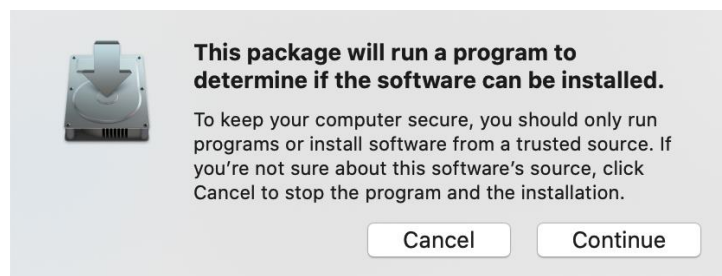
4] Double-Click on the dmg file.



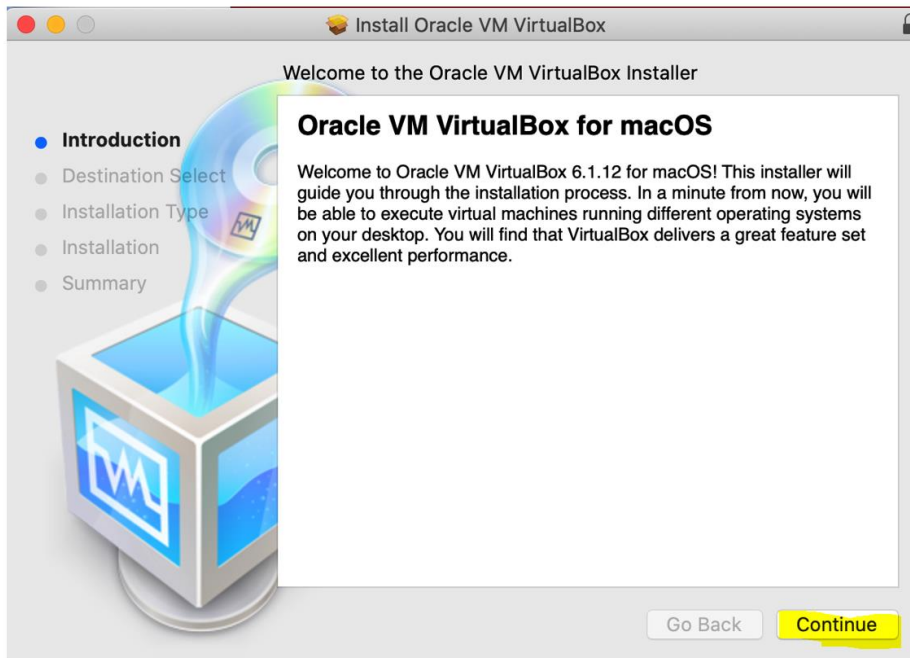
5] As directed above, double-click on the VirtualBox.pkg.



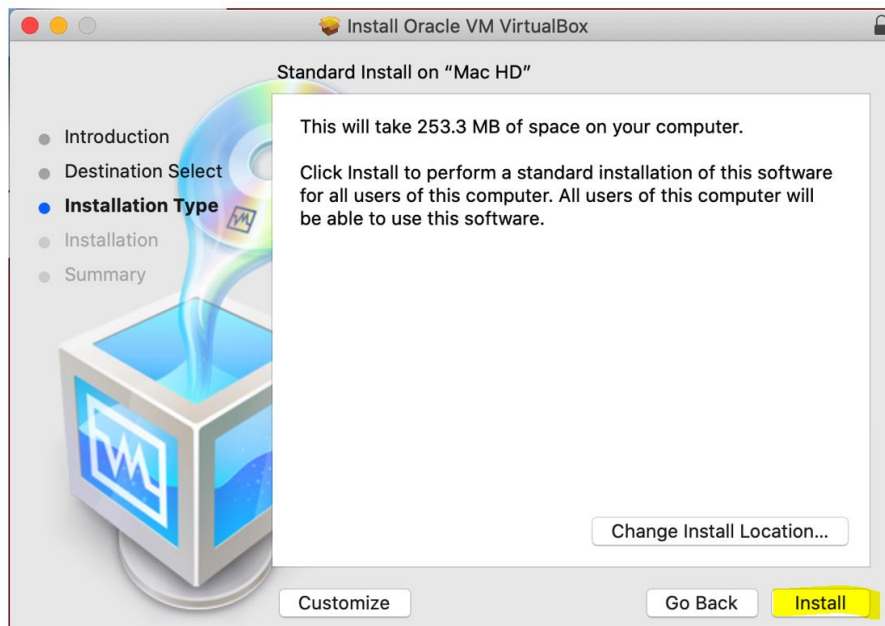
6] Push the Continue button.



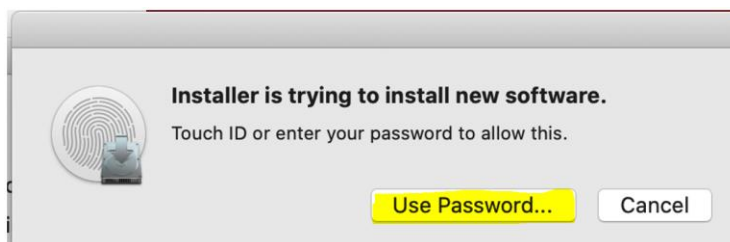
7] Push the Continue button.



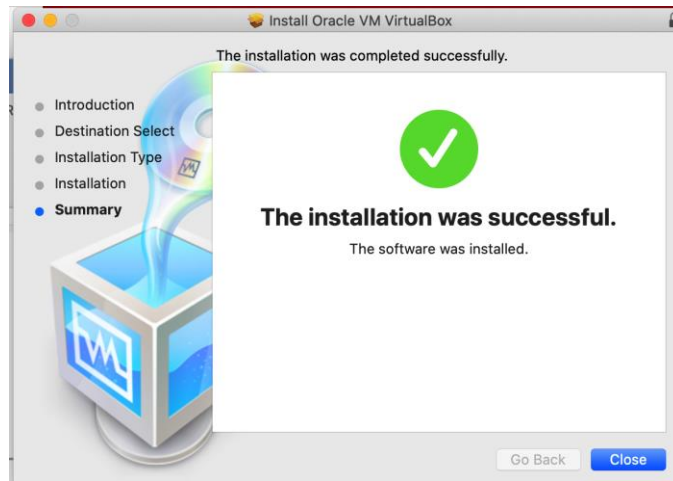
8] Push the Install button.
