- Welcome To Have A Extra-Credit More-Advanced Interface For Power Users → Save It For Final Presentation!

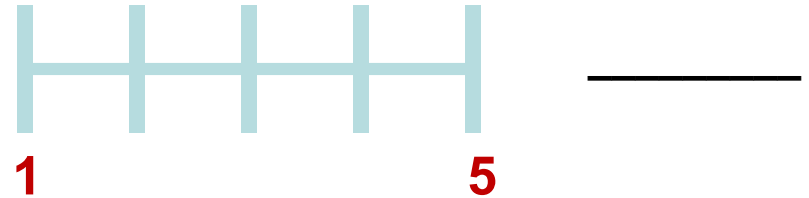

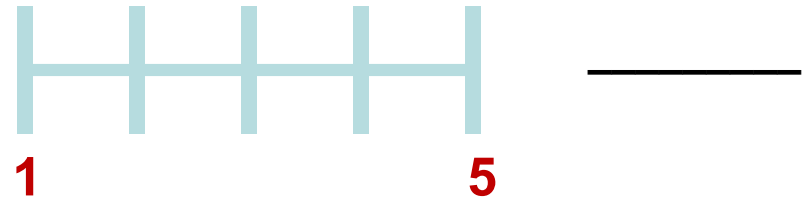

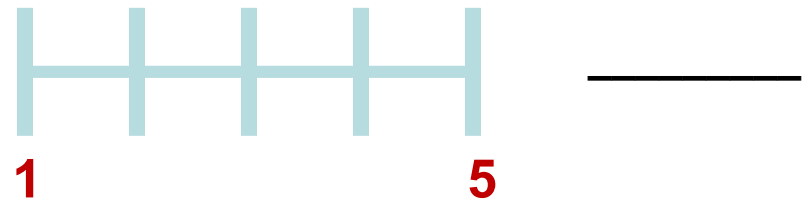
